Early Years Big Adventures.

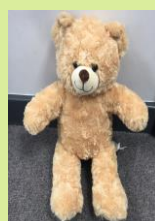
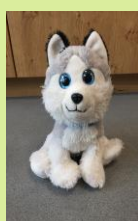
Every week Nursery, RTM and REK Class Teddy will be taken home by a member of the class.

Attendance

The national expectation for pupil's attendance is, 95%.

If your child's attendance is to fall below 95%, you will be expected to attend a meeting with the Head of School to discuss our concerns and for us to help resolve any issues.

Please make sure, if your child has an appointment, e.g. Dentist or Doctors, you bring in an appointment card to the main office. This is to ensure, that your child is not marked down as an unauthorised absence however, this will still class as an absence and within your 10 days absence allowance.

Every Monday in worship assembly, the class with the highest percentage of attendance will be announced.

The class with the highest percentage will receive **Golden time** on a Friday afternoon.

At present our attendance for the **whole school** stands at **94.1%** from the beginning of the year.
