

Year 4 Spring Term

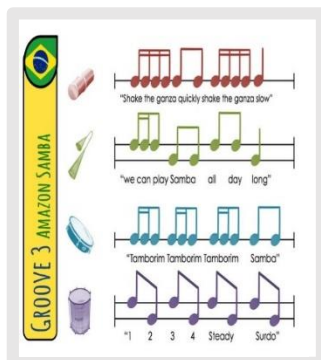
In Literacy, the children have enjoyed reading the book 'The Boy in The Back of The Class'. They also enjoyed writing their own creative stories during National Story Telling Week: this enabled them to get in touch with their creative spark and curiosity!



In Science, the children have been experimenting and focussing on the topic of electricity. They have successfully predicted whether or not circuits will work by identifying complete and incomplete circuits.

In Art, the children sketched still life images and drew the outline of a variety of holiday items.

In Music, they have learnt about the style of Samba Music including the various instruments and syncopated rhythms involved.



In R.E. the children have wholly enjoyed learning about the Easter story focusing on the 10th Station of the Cross.
