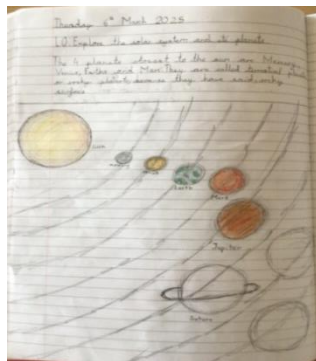
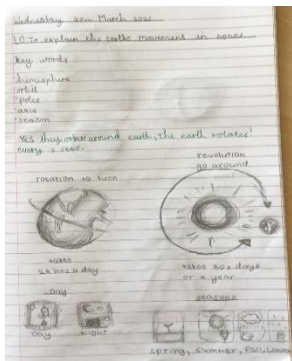
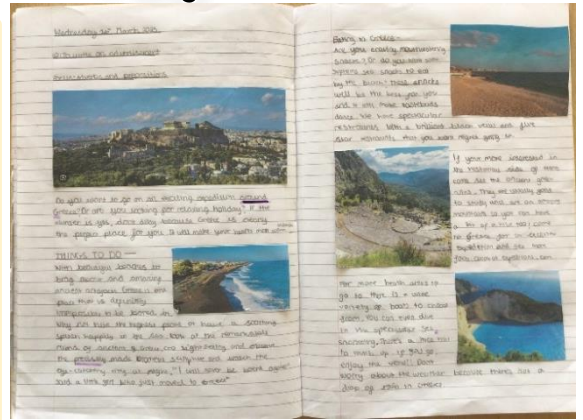


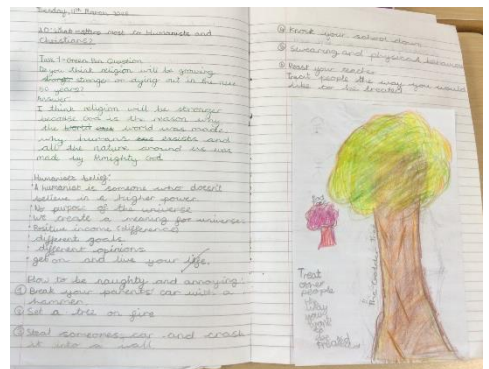
# Year 5 Spring Term

Literacy: The children have explored various genres and have learnt a number of grammar skills. They have been adding rhetorical questions, adverbs and prepositions to their persuasive writing and have also worked on an advertisement and a story.



Science: The children have had the opportunity to learn more about the Earth and the celestial bodies in our solar system. They also explored how scientific ideas surrounding Earth's movement and placement have changed and developed over time.

Our RE lessons are an opportunity for the children to share ideas and opinions. They have explored Religion from a religious and non-religious point of view, looking at how the views of Humanists compare to those of Christians. The children considered how each group came up with their values and beliefs.



In DT, the children explored the journey of food- from the farm to the home- gaining a better understanding of how we get our fresh food. They also learned how to make Spaghetti Bolognese.

We have been learning about Ancient Greece. We explored the time line of their civilisation and also the gods of the Greeks. They learnt that Athens was the home of democracy, which influenced democracy around the world.
