

Lighthouse Spring Term

This term, we focused on four stories: "The Very Hungry Caterpillar", "A Squash and a Squeeze", "Farmyard Hullabaloo," along with "The Enormous Turnip." The children enjoyed exploring these tales through a multi-sensory approach.



In Art and DT, the children have made a range of farmyard animals. Each creation helps to enhance different fine motor skills. The children used various materials and artistic techniques.



In our core word programme, where we concentrate on one key word at a time, the children engaged with stories, songs, signs, and visuals to create a multi communication approach to learning and understanding important everyday vocabulary. This term's focus words included: who, help, they, you, where, up, down.



In a recent trip, the children visited a nearby shop where they had the opportunity to practise their money counting skills. The children have also been exploring the theme of growth, learning about how both humans and plants grow. They now have a good understanding of what is needed for a plant to grow.
