Key Facts

Remember to plan where your stitches will go on the pouch **template**.



When cutting the **template** out, be careful and as **accurate** as possible.



Vocabulary

Accurate	Neat, correct shape, size and pattern, no mistakes.
Fabric	A natural or man-made woven or knitted material this is made from plant fibers, animal fur or synthetic materials.
Knot	A join made by tying two pieces of string or rope together.
Running Stitch	A simple style of sewing in a straight line with no overlapping.
Sew	To join or fasten by stitches made using needle and thread.
Shape	The form of an object.
Stencils	A shape that you can draw around.
Template	A stencil which you use to help you draw a shape more easily or to different materials.
Thimble	A small metal cap to cover and protect your finger when sewing.
