SCHOOL SCOOTERS AND BIKES

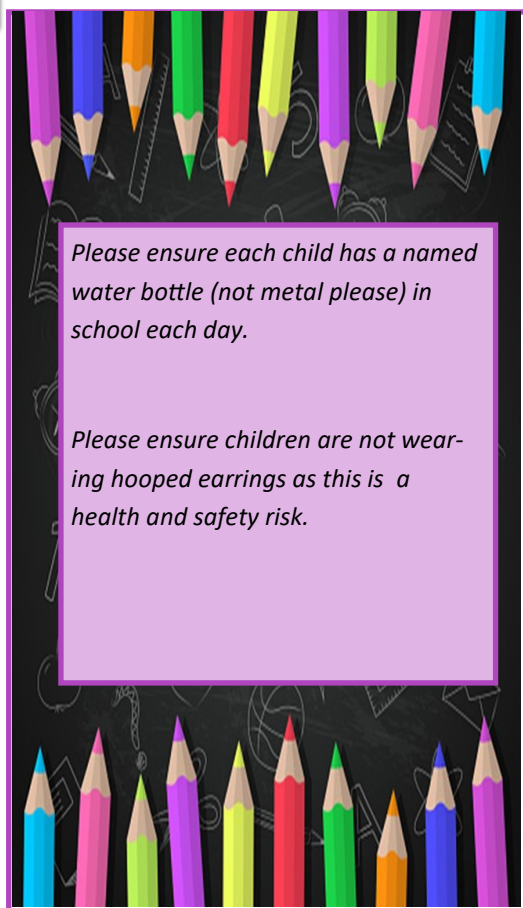
